

CONSULTATION

The Parish Council are consultees in many areas from District County and Government departments as well as other agencies whose work impacts on the life of residents.

Planning Applications: These are the most frequent documents that come before the Council and can have a significant impact on a parish. Nevertheless the Council has to base comments on planning policy and generalisations or subjective views are not enough to support or object to an application.

Discussions take place in the public domain at monthly meetings and reported in Council Minutes. However residents are welcome to take a more active role and encouraged to attend Parish Council meetings and their input is welcomed and valued.

There have been, over the years, more significant or contentious matters that deserve and require wider involvement – such as the Parish Plan and housing development. On these occasions a more public event will be arranged and given wider publicity to ensure maximum feedback from residents.
